**Hillside Cottage, Newgrounds, Godshill - 2No. single storey extensions; roof terrace; 2No. additional rooflights; 1No. window:** Following a lengthy discussion on the complex nature of the plans and the difficulty in interpreting them and how the proposals would affect the neighbouring properties, Cllr Fell proposed from the Chair and it was RESOLVED that the decision on this application be deferred to the next meeting.
