The income from hiring and thus the usage of the Hall is in decline while the running costs remain the same. In this current situation, the future of the Hall could be under threat as the funds in reserve would only last another 4-5 years if the Hall continues to make a loss year on year.

While the Management Committee continues to fund raise for the Village Hall to supplement the low rate of hiring, more regular bookings for clubs, groups or entertainment are needed. Income for the Hall comes entirely from bookings and donations.

If you are planning a special celebration or would like to organise an event to raise funds for a cause of your own, then do consider using the Village Hall. The building is in excellent order, maintained by a professional visit each month, with a fully equipped kitchen for catering, seating for up to 80 people, a stage, party lighting and a skittle alley. There is car parking, easy access to the building.
