## Vegetable and Fruit Classes

1. 6 Potatoes of the same named variety on a paper plate
2. 6 Tomatoes of the same named variety on a paper plate
3. 6 French Beans of the same named variety on a paper plate
4. A plate of Chillies
5. The heaviest Marrow
6. A tray of mixed vegetables arranged for effect
7. A saucer of soft fruit
8. Any other fruit – one specimen only
9. A basket of home grown fruit arranged for effect – accessories allowed

## Flower Classes

10. 1 stem any Rose to be judged on scent
11. 2 stems of the same Rose to be exhibited in a vase
12. 3 Sunflowers in a vase
13. Any other flower – 3 specimens of the same variety
14. A cactus or succulent in a pot
15. 3 sprays of flowering shrubs
16. 5 stems of contrasting foliage in a vase
17. An arrangement of home grown flowers and foliage in a wellie
18. A miniature arrangement of home grown flowers and foliage in an espresso cup and saucer, max size 15cmx15cmx15cm

## Handicrafts

19. A photograph “Party Time” – maximum size 18cm x 13cm
20. A historical family portrait framed or unframed
21. A home crafted head band, any style
